Next Meeting

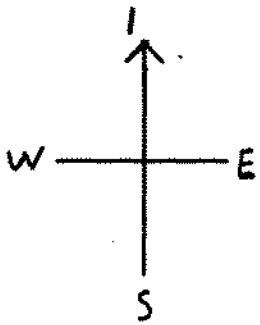
